## **January Diary.**

Saturday 3 January – Vlei Walk – let's start the year with a flourish!

Tuesday 13 January – Outing – a special beginning to 2015! We will visit B P Greyling's farm, directions to follow. We will leave the Library at 07h00 sharp as Karen Greyling is providing breakfast (!) at 08h00 for those attending. We would like an idea of numbers so please let me know if you would like to join in.

Weekend of 16-18 January – SANParks Honorary Rangers, Newcastle Branch is holding the first Birding Weekend. Their programme is not available at this point, there will be a Vlei Market on Saturday as well. Some 60 visitors have booked already and we will need some volunteers to man birding points. Please help!

Wednesday 21 January – talk by Peter Nelson of Ladysmith Bird Club. He will talk about the development of Ingula Nature Reserve, and discuss the complexities of building a power station in a sensitive ecological area. He will focus on the impact on the natural environment and the bird life they found in the area.

1.
